FESTIVAL RULES

- 1. The Festival will be presenting the classical dance styles in solo performances:
 - i) Bharata Natyam
 - ii) Kathak
 - iii) Kathakali
 - iv) Manipuri
 - v) Kuchipudi
 - vi) Odissi
 - vii) Mohini Attam.
 - viii) Kudiyattam
 - ix) Nangyar Kuttu
 - x) Sattriya
- 2. Eligibility: Between 20 years and 35 years as on 10th Oct, 2016.
- 3. Applicants should send a good quality D.V.D. of **15 minutes** duration of their performance in the chosen dance style. The dance should be performed in **traditional costume** and should consist of both **nritta** and **abhinaya**. Only items from the traditional repertoire must be presented.
- 4. Only solo performances must be submitted. DVDs of duets or groups will not be considered for selection.
- 5. A Selection Panel will view the DVD and select performers. The decision of the Panel will be Final. No enquiries or appeals will be entertained.
- 6. Applicants should send two recent hard copy photographs in traditional dance costume.
- 7. The selected applicants are expected to present the prescribed item in their chosen dance style.
- 8. Applicants selected would be given maximum 30 minutes. Anyone exceeding this time limit will not be considered for the award.
- 9. The selected artistes can present their performance either to live music or pre-recorded CD.

CAUTION:

Please note that selected artistes cannot present their dance to a commercially recorded and marketed musical CD. This condition has to be strictly followed in order to avoid any disputes arising out of copyrights etc. The performance must be on specially recorded music specific to the item being performed.

The applicant must specify whether she / he is going to perform on live music or prerecorded music CD. 10. The selected artistes will be paid consolidated honorarium as follows: -

Out station Artistes: Rs.18,000/- (Rs. Eighteen thousand only) with live music Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand only) with recorded music.

Local Artistes: Mumbai, Pune, Nasik, Surat

Rs.10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand only) with live music Rs.8000/- (Rs. Eight thousand only) with recorded music.

- 11. Selected applicants will be intimated by mail / post by the Second week of November, 2016.
- 12. Maximum of seven dancers will be honoured by 'Nalanda Nritya Nipuna' award. The awards will be announced at a later date. The winners will be informed accordingly.
- 13. Those who have already performed in Nrityotsava should not apply.
